Performing	<ul> <li>Can deliver character lines during a performance.</li> <li>Can show some evidence of character while speaking character lines.</li> <li>Will need a script to help remember character lines.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can choose some appropriate movement and voice for a basic character.</li> <li>Can sustain a role they have created for some of the performance.</li> <li>Will be able to remember some character lines without a script.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can perform a character (using voice, movement, facial expression and gesture) that shows some thought and difference from themselves.</li> <li>Can stay in role for a reasonable amount of time during their performance, occasionally struggling to keep focused.</li> <li>Character lines are performed with some mistakes.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can perform characters that are different from themselves (using voice, movement, body language, facial expression and gesture) with growing confidence and originality.</li> <li>Can stay in role for most of the performance with few distractions.</li> <li>Character lines are performed with occasional mistakes.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can perform a variety of convincing characters (using voice, movement, body language, facial expression and gesture) with confidence and originality.</li> <li>Can consistently stay in role for the whole of a performance.</li> <li>Any character lines are delivered with very few mistakes, if any.</li> </ul>
Evaluating	<ul> <li>Can make basic comments about others work.</li> <li>Can listen to points made by others about their own performance.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can comment about others work using some drama language.</li> <li>Can understand points made by others about their own performance.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can talk about which performance worked well and giving good reason.</li> <li>Responds well to points made by others about their own performance.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Can discuss how ideas are shown, stories developed and characters performed using correct language.</li> <li>Can respond to constructive criticism provided by others and apply it to their own work.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Provides reasons for choices in drama using past and present knowledge.</li> <li>Can analyse how actor's directors and designers achieve specific effects.</li> </ul>
