## Arrangements: Year 11 Study Leave post half term

Year 11 students have made an excellent start to their summer examinations and I'm very proud of the resilience they continue to show. To further support Year 11 students they will be permitted to be on **full study leave** meaning they are only expected to be on school site whilst undertaking their examination. Students are expected to leave school the school site in between a morning and afternoon exam, should they have two exams during one day.

I would like to also take this opportunity to remind you of timings:

- For morning examinations, students are to be at their examination venue **by 8.30am**, adhering to the line-up requirements, with full equipment and wearing correct full school uniform.
- For afternoon examinations, students are to be at their examination venue **by 1.15pm**, adhering to the line-up requirements with full equipment and wearing correct full school uniform.

Attendance to all exams, to include being on time, is a requirement of all students to ensure the external examinations run smoothly for all students. As a parent/carer I politely remind you that it is your responsibility for making sure your child attends all of their timetabled examinations on time.
