



Main Terms and Conditions for the hire of The Mark Rutherford School- Harpur Trust Portable Planetarium

For there to be an enforceable agreement in place there must be some consideration by the hirer (school) for receiving the planetarium.

These considerations will be in the form of obligations to;

- 1) keep the planetarium in good condition
- 2) to keep it secure
- 3) to only use it for educational purposes
- 4) to use the equipment without fees for participation
- 5) to ensure correct permissions for viewing all material
- 6) accept liability for any damage sustained whilst in your hire
- 7) accept liability for any injury sustained by your students and staff whilst in your use
