

Uniform Guidelines – (The school uniform shop is open 1st and 2nd September 9am – 12pm)

- Skirt- plain, black, knee length or below, without slit side or back seam.
- Trousers- black.
- White traditional, tucked in shirt, with collar, suitable to wear with the accompanying school tie, buttoned to the neck. During the summer term only, blue polo shirts with the school name in House colours may be worn.
- Blazer- Black, with the school name or badge.
- Jumper- black V neck with the school name or plain. Jumpers may only be worn under a blazer.
- School tie in house colours.
- Shoes- black.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Can I wear make-up?

Yes, although it must be discrete.

Can I wear jewellery?

Yes, you can wear a watch and a pair of stud earrings. You will be expected to remove earrings which hang below the ear, rings and any other jewellery when you are in school.

Are facial/body piercings allowed?

No

Can I colour my hair?

Yes, although coloured hair where the colour is not a normal hair colour is not permitted.

Am I allowed to wear a cardigan or a hoodie instead of the school jumper?

NO. However, you are allowed to wear a top coat over the school blazer. Top coats must always be removed in classrooms, unless you are instructed otherwise by the teacher.

Am I allowed to wear a scarf?

Yes. If a student wishes to wear a scarf for the purpose of keeping warm, this must be a plain black scarf although it must be removed inside.

Can belts be worn?

Yes, as long as they are plain and black.

Can I wear black trainers instead of black shoes?

No. Trainers and trainer styles, boots, plimsolls, sandals, open toed, high heeled or platform shoes and other unsuitable footwear must not be worn. Parents are advised to buy sensible shoes for their children, which do not place undue stress on the feet. Black school shoes should be worn all year round until the last day of every term.

What happens if I cannot wear shoes for medical reasons?

Under these circumstances other suitable footwear will be allowed. Normally confirmation of the need must be received from parents/carers. For long term medical problems a medical note from the doctor may be requested.

Can I wear black jeans?

No. jeans, combat style wear and sports wear must not be worn.

What will happen if I do not wear the correct uniform?

A variety of measures will be used. Students will be asked to dress correctly, removing unacceptable garments or jewellery. If this is not possible, or the school believes that a student will not respect the uniform guidelines once out of sight, they will be isolated from other students until such time that they meet the guidelines. In extreme or persistent cases students may be sent home to change, following contact with parents.

How will I know if, during the school year, a new fashion is acceptable?

In light of the pace at which fashion changes, the school reserves the right to amend the guidelines concerning the wearing of uniform and hairstyles where necessary. Parents will be advised of such changes via the school website. As a guideline, always ask first!

What happens if I lose an item of my uniform or an item of jewellery?

The school accepts no responsibility for lost items of uniform or jewellery. Therefore, parents are advised, in their own interests to make sure that all clothing is clearly marked, permanently, with the student's name.
