Academic Mentoring Day (Friday 3rd July 2026)

On Friday 3rd July 2026 we are hosting our end of year Academic Mentoring Day. It gives us the opportunity to answer any questions you may have, and to review the progress of your child, from across this school year.

Students will not be in school on this day for lessons, however, they will attend a 10-minute one-to-one appointment with their Tutor and/or Head of Year with you as their parent/carers. They do not need to wear their school uniform but **please get them to bring their planner with them**. Students will be signposted to complete independent work online for this day.

For parents/carers of students in our Nightingale Unit, you will be contacted separately to make an appointment to meet with a member of staff from this provision.

Appointments will take place during the following times:

- 09.00am to 11.00am
- 11.30am to 13.00pm
- 13.30pm to 15.00pm

Appointments will be held in person and are bookable via SchoolCloud now; please follow the link [here](#). The booking system will close at 6pm on Wednesday 1st July 2026.

If you are driving onto the school site, please turn left as you enter the vehicle gate and park in one of the spaces. Your child can take you directly to their tutor room, for your appointment. You are welcome to pick up light refreshments before or after your appointment from our Canteen.

If you require support to access our site or need an appointment in a downstairs classroom, please contact us so we can arrange this for you.

In addition to the Academic Mentoring appointments, we will be hosting some workshops to provide additional support to our parents and carers. These will include sessions on;

- *The Teen Brain* – Helping to understand adolescent neurological development, managing shifting emotions and improve communication.
- *Managing Exam Stress* – Some practical tips to help alleviate stress build up prior to examination periods.
- *How you feel matters* - a workshop to recognise, validate and offer strategies to manage your emotions.

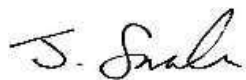
