GCE Results Day

GCE (A Level) Results Day will take place on **Thursday 13th August 2026**. Students will be able to collect their results from the **Garner Lecture Theatre** between **9am - 12pm**. Refreshments will be available. Members of the Sixth Form Team and senior staff will be available throughout the morning to offer guidance and support with Sixth Form enrolment, college applications and post-16 decisions.

Sixth Form staff will also be in school on **Friday 14th August between 9am and 12pm**, in the Sixth Form Common Room, to support students with any university application queries. Students are welcome to come in on this day to talk about their next steps.

If students are unable to collect their results in person and would like to nominate a friend or family member to collect them, they should email exams@mrus.co.uk by Tuesday 11th August, naming the person who they nominate. The person (unless they are a current student) will need to bring a photographic form of identification with them, ideally a driving licence or passport. Under no circumstances will results be given out over the telephone.

Students awaiting BTEC results will receive an email from **Credly**, an online results service linked to Pearson. Students need to click the link in the email to set up an account using their personal email address so that they will be able to access and store online information regarding their results.

Resources donations

Students are encouraged to donate books, revision guides or other educational resources that are no longer required. These items can make a significant difference to other families within our school community and may be brought to school on results day.

We are looking forward to our students receiving their results in August, celebrating their achievements and hearing about their future plans. Please note that school closes for the summer break on Friday 17th July and reopens to students on Thursday 3rd September 2026.
