Academic Mentoring Day (Friday 2nd October 2026)

On Friday 2nd October 2026 we are hosting our Academic Mentoring Day. It gives us the opportunity to answer any questions you may have, to review the progress of your child, in the opening weeks of term, and to set targets for the rest of the year.

Students will not be in school on this day for lessons, however, they will attend a 10-minute one-to-one appointment with their Tutor and/or Head of Year with you as their parent/carer. They do not need to wear their school uniform but **please get them to bring their planner with them**. Students will be signposted to complete independent work online for this day.

For parents/carers of students in our Nightingale Unit, you will be contacted separately to make an appointment to meet with a member of staff from this provision.

Appointments will take place during the following times:

- 09.00am to 11.00am
- 11.30am to 13.00pm
- 13.30pm to 15.00pm

Appointments will be held in person and are bookable via SchoolCloud now; please follow the link [here](#). The booking system will close at 6pm on Thursday 1st October 2026.

If you are driving onto the school site, please turn left as you enter the vehicle gate and park in one of the spaces. Your child can take you directly to their tutor room, for your appointment. You are welcome to pick up light refreshments before or after your appointment from our Canteen.

If you require support to access our site or need an appointment in a downstairs classroom, please contact us so we can arrange this for you.

In addition to the Academic Mentoring appointments, we will be hosting some workshops to provide additional support to our parents and carers. Further information, and instructions on how to sign up, will be sent out at a later date.

We will be requesting your feedback following this day via an online survey to ensure we continue to listen to the needs of our school community and improve our provision.
