

Key Stage 4 results School Performance Table 2022

Progress 8 is a national performance indicator aimed at measuring pupil progress across a set of eight subjects. Students' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils with the same prior attainment in their Key Stage 2 tests at the end of Year 6. Attainment 8 is another national performance indicator measuring a student's average grade across eight subjects.

- **Discussing with the school or college** factors that may have influenced these results and consider a range of information when forming a view on how well a school or college is doing, including pupil/student population information.
