Academic Mentoring Day (Friday 4th October 2024)

On Friday 4th October 2024 we are hosting an Academic Mentoring Day; this is something we introduced last academic year to review how your child has settled into the new academic year and to answer any questions you may have whilst also understanding the expectations of our core values of Motivated, Respectful and Successful in relation to students' learning and their behaviour.

Students will not be in school on this day for lessons however, will attend a 10 minute one-to-one appointment with their Tutor and/or Head of Year with you as their parent/carers. They do not need to wear their school uniform however, are required to bring their planner with them. Students will be signposted to complete independent work online for this day.

For parents/carers of students in our Nightingale Unit, you will be contacted separately to make an appointment to meet with a member of staff from this provision.

Appointments will take place during the following times:

- 09.00 to 11.00
- 11.30 to 13.00
- 13.30 to 15.00

Appointments will be held in person and are bookable via SchoolCloud now; please follow the link [here](#). The booking system will close at 6pm on Monday 30th September 2024. You are asked to arrive via our pedestrian gate and enter via the door at the end of the path alongside the Canteen where you will be met by our student leaders and staff. You will be asked to sign in and out in our Space 4 Learning to maintain the safety of our site at all times. You will also be able to pick up light refreshments before or after your appointment from our Canteen.

We are keen to welcome you into our school in order to meet your child's Tutor and further develop those first 'port of call' relationships.
