



Dress Code

Detailed below is the dress code for the Sixth Form. It is important that students are dressed appropriately for a teaching and learning environment as well as setting the right example to the rest of the students in the school.

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Other:

- No visible tattoos;
- No visible piercings except in the ears. Earrings should be discreet (students who have visible piercings elsewhere will be requested to remove the stud or hoop and give to their Tutor for collection at the end of the day in the first instance);
- Make-up should be suitable for a working business environment;
- For PE and practical dance lessons students must bring appropriate clothing to change into.
- The Director of Sixth Form and Heads of Year 12 and 13 have the final decision regarding what is and is not suitable attire for the Sixth Form. The school reserves the right to send home any student who is not properly dressed where he/she should change to meet the requirements of this published dress code and then return to school the same day to resume his/her studies.
- Persistent disregard for this code of dress will result in further action being taken.
- We retain the right to act as the final authority in the interpretation of the dress code. If you are unsure, parents/carers and students are advised to contact the Director of Sixth Form for clarification before purchasing an item.
